- 5 types of gem stones
- 5 whole betel nuts (supari)
- A number of Silver Laxmi-Ganesh coins (10 gms or more) and a deity form of Laxmi-Ganesh (or substitute a Laxmi-Ganesh coin for the deities).
- Asan to be seated on
- Agarbatti
- Bangles
- Basil leafs (Tulsi patra)
- Betel leaf
- Bichiya
- Bookkeeping (bahi-khata)
- Chandan
- Cloves (Launga)
- Coconut (naariyal)
- Coins
- Collyrium (Kajal)
- Coriandrum sativum
- Curd (Dahi)
- Custard Apple (Seetafal)
- Dhoop & Dhoopdaan
- Dhoop batti

- Empowered 11 Dhanteras Candles or 11 other available pink and purple candles.
- Flowers, Rice, Roli
- Ganga jal (holy water)
- Garland (Pushp mala)
- Haldi
- Honey
- Janeu
- Kapoor
- Kesar
- Kheel & Batasha
- Leafs of Banyan(badh), sycamore (Goolar), Ficus religiosa (peepal), mango (Aam) and Paakar
- Mehandi
- Milk
- One Deepak/Diya made of flour dough with 4 wicks
- Panicum (Durva)
- Payal
- Pen (Kalam)
- Perfume (Itra)
- Photo or statue of Goddess Laxmi
- Red cotton cloth

- Sacred Water and a Spoon
- Saptdhanya (grain of seven types)

- Silver brick of 25 gms or 50 or 100 gms, with perfectly straight edges and 90 degree corners (no substitutes for this are possible)

- Small pan or kadhai (wok)–This has to be a new previously unused utensil
- Statue of Goddess Saraswati
- Statue of Lord ganesha
- Sugar
- Sugar Cane (Ganna)
